Ms. Berry mentioned an increase to the number of wet areas in front of the greens on Patriot despite the lack of rain. She asked if the output for the sprinklers could to be checked by maintenance.

6. Golf Operations: Mr. John Cook provided a report on golf operations.

a. Upcoming Tournaments and Events. The Links at Redstone will hold the Senior Club Championship, 21–22 September. There are many other tournaments also scheduled during September. League play will be ending in October.

b. Course Maintenance. Mr. Larry Underwood, Golf Course Superintendent, made a request that rakes remain in the bunker.

c. Mr. Cook mentioned the course does not have handicap flags for the carts. A single 3-wheel cart can be requested if players have limitations on walking and require to be closer to the green.

d. The new Golf Course Manager, Mr. Gary Haught, should arrive the end of September.

e. The membership is currently at 227.

7. Handicap Committee Report:

a. Tournaments. Mr. Small reported that the committee marked the course for the Club Championship Tournament in August and will mark the course for the upcoming Senior Club Championship Tournament. The committee will ensure tournament scores are adjusted for Equitable Stroke Control for both tournaments before they are entered into the Golf Handicap Information Network.

b. Stakes Removal. Mr. Small reported that the committee removed the following stakes:

(1) The red stakes on the right at Patriot #2.

(2) The red and yellow stakes in the ditch, that runs across the fairway, at Patriot #14.

8. Volunteer Committee Report:


a. Range Ball Barn. Mr. DeJong noted that the barn will be finished when the weather is a little cooler.

b. Flowerbeds. Ms. Stirling reported that she is looking for someone to maintain the flowerbed at Warrior #10. September will be major gardening month to trim back the bushes and ready the beds for the fall and winter.
