1. The Golf Advisory Council held its meeting, 4 May 2023, The Links at Redstone.
2. The agenda for the meeting is enclosed.
3. The following members/representatives were present:

4. The following members were not present:

  - Ms. Dee Thonus – Member at Large
  - Ms. Mary Russell – Member at Large
5. Opening Remarks: Mr. Small opened the meeting at 1208.
6. Golf operations: Mr. Haught provided a report on golf operations.
  - a. Mr. Haught reported that parts have been received for the well repair on hole number 10 and it will be up and running soon.
  - b. The new scorecards are now available with the updated course information. The old scorecards will be used until they are gone.

c. The course is still on schedule for delivery of the new electric golf carts. Mr. Haught stated that a few of the gas carts will be retained for use by the staff and as rentals for off course activities.

d. The aeration of the course fairways is almost complete. Holes one through twelve on Patriot and all of Warrior have been completed. The greens will be aerated beginning 1 June and will be completely healed by the end of June.

e. The parking lot appearance is much improved with the new asphalt and markings.

f. Mr. Haught mentioned they will be laying sod around the pump house on Patriot, as well as the bunkers on Patriot 9 and Warrior 8. Mr. Haught is aware of additional bunkers that will require some repairs in the future.

g. The cart ball washers are leaking at the drain plug and needing to be replaced. Mr. Haught found a replacement that will correct the problem and will cost less than the standard plug.

h. A work order has been submitted for new toilets and safety bars for both the Patriot and Warrior restrooms.

i. The Links at Redstone is still short on personnel in the maintenance and restaurant areas.

7. Volunteer Committee Report: Ms. Stirling has stated that volunteers would be willing to assist in updating the paint colors on the monuments to reflect the change in the colors of tee markers. Volunteers will also help in repainting the forward markers with a brighter green to make them more easily located on the course.

8. Ladies League Golf Report: Ms. Stirling reported that the new tee times were now in effect and turn out increased with the warmer weather.

9. Mr. Small adjourned the meeting at 1308.
