

### Use of Bicycles in RTC Range by Hunters

- Only hunters signed in through HuntTrac are authorized to use bicycles inside the RTC Range.
- No gas/electric bicycles are allowed.
- Hunters will not ride a bicycle with a loaded weapon (if muzzleloader - removal of cap/primer/flash powder is sufficient).
- Bicycle use is limited to the paved and gravel maintained roads. No riding in firebreaks, game trails or in the woods/fields.
- Hunters will not, under any circumstances, leave/park/lay their bicycles on ANY road. Bicycles will not be left in the range overnight, they must be removed when the hunter checks out of the area.
- Bicycles must be clearly marked, with the hunter's name.
- If a bicycle issue arises, contact Conservation Law Enforcement.
- The use of a bicycle helmet is mandatory in accordance with the installation bicycle policy.
- Hunter orange requirements are still in effect whether walking or biking. Once you arrive to your destination immediately switch out to hunter orange headgear.
- Hunters may utilize a small trailer/cart pulled behind a bicycle to help carry gear. Trailer/cart must also display the name of the hunter.
- Safety is paramount any questions refer to Conservation Officers.
