1. The Golf Advisory Council conducted a meeting 4 October 2018, 1130, The Links at Redstone.

6. Opening Remarks: Mr. Small opened the meeting at 1132. It was noted that as of today's date, the minutes from the September meeting have not been received as signed/approved.

7. Golf Operations: Mr. Kea provided the report on golf operations.

a. The Senior Golf Championship, which was held 15-16 September, was a good event.

b. The over seeding on Patriot is doing well and will be open for play Saturday, 6 October.

c. The Garrison Scramble is scheduled for 13 October. A Texas format for putting from tee to green will be the format used for the Scramble. This format requires players to rotate turns putting on the green. The order continues through all 18 greens. Player A – Player D take turns until the ball is in the cup. If Player C holes out, Player D will putt first on the next green.

d. The Links will hold its annual Chili Cook-off, 27 October.

8. Handicap Committee Report: Mr. Small reported that the committee assisted with the Senior Club Championship; addressing flighting issues and marking the course. The Committee reviewed the scorecards and made adjustments to the gross score, using equitable stroke control (ESC) when necessary. The staff of The Links posted the scores in GHIN for the players.

9. Volunteer Committee Report: Ms. Stirling noted Big Volunteer Day will be held 20 October 2018.

10. Ladies Golf Report: Ms. Stirling stated the group continues to do well. The final play day will be 31 October and will conclude with a luncheon.

11. Representatives/Individual Report/Open Discussion:

a. MG Thurgood mentioned that he met with COL Smith, Garrison Commander, US Army Garrison, Redstone, to discuss visitor access for golf patrons. The Commander is looking at introducing the "Rocket Card" which will allow a guest access to Redstone Arsenal on an annual basis. Mr. Kea and Mr. Nunn mentioned this would be helpful in order to increase access to the golf course. They also noted that they typically grant access to over 200 guests annually for events; league play, tournament events, vendor access, and individual play.



c. Mr. Cook announced that a Cobra Demo Day is scheduled for 10 October 2018, 1100-1500. The Links is working to have 3 or 4 more demo days before the end of 2018.

12. Mr. Small adjourned the meeting at 1228 and thanked everyone for their support and their attendance.
