5. Opening Remarks: Mr. Small opened the meeting at 1138 and welcomed everyone back to a new golf season.

6. Golf Operations: Mr. Haught provided a report on golf operations.

a. Staffing

- (1) Retirements Mr. Larry Underwood, Golf Course Superintendent, and Mr. Egbert "Boop" Martin, Manager of the Weeden Mountain Grill, have retired.
- (2) New Hires Mr. Mike Smith was hired over the winter as the Golf Course Superintendent and an Assistant Golf Course Superintendent will be coming on-board soon. Mr. Smith currently has six maintenance personnel and this small staff has been preparing the golf course for the spring season.
- (3) Open Positions The golf course has posted various positions on USA Jobs; to include starters, kitchen staff, and maintenance.

b. Course Maintenance

- (1) Aeriation of Greens The Warrior Course is scheduled for aeriation 17 May and Patriot will follow 1 June, weather permitting.
- (2) Dragging and Blowing Fairways The staff has been working to remove the extra grass clippings and thatch in the fairways in order to improve grass growth and playability.
- (3) Pre-emergent The golf course will schedule a fall pre-emergent to reduce winter weeds, as well as improve the growing season in the spring.

- 8. Volunteer Committee Report: Ms. Stirling stated that volunteers are working on their gardens. Ms. Stirling asked if the golf course will be providing mulch or if the volunteers should obtain mulch for reimbursement. Mr. Haught stated that the golf course would provide the mulch for the flowerbeds.
- 9. Ladies Golf Report: Ms. Stirling noted that a smaller group of ladies will play this year. The group is still working on details for their first luncheon. Ms. Stirling will work with the golf course for scheduling tee times or a shotgun start, depending on the number of ladies playing each week.
- 10. Representatives/Individual Report/Open Discussion:
- a. Mr. Small asked if any changes should be made to the Charter regarding the current 13 member positions. The council discussed this proposal and agreed that no changes should be made at this time.
- b. Mr. Small asked if the start of the meeting could return to 1200. There was no objection to changing the start time of the meeting.
